REPORT ON WALK AGAINST DRUG ABUSE–10TH NOVEMBER 2018

The incidence of drug abuse among children and adolescents is higher than the general population. This is notably because youth is a time for experimentation and identity forming. In India an NGO revealed that 63.6% of patients coming in for treatment were introduced to drugs at a young age below 15 years. There are very few health centers that deal with child abuse problems, especially in the rural areas. The use of tobacco is another major concern among children.

REPORT ON DIABETES SCREENING PROGRAMME- 14TH NOVEMBER 2018

On the occasion of World Diabetes Day 2018, themed "Diabetes and family", Krupanidhi College of Pharmacy organized a Diabetes Screening Program in Collaboration with Kshema Hospital in Kodathi Village as part of its Community service.Volunteers conducted a house to house Diabetes screening service for the public of Kodathi village.

The programme started at 7:30am and continued till 1:00pm. The GRBS and FBS of interested population was checked and documented in a profile form including their demographic details, past medical history, family history and last meal time. Diabetes information leaflets were distributed to public. Newly diagnosed and pre-diabetic patients were ounseled on diet and life style modifications.

A total of 130 people were screened, out of which 26 were screened as diabetic based on elevated blood glucose levels. Among the 26 diabetics, 17 were known case and 9 were newly detected.

Volunteers ounseled this population and convinced them to have a proper blood glucose test done both fasting and post-prandial blood sugar at least once in every 2 to 3 months.

The awareness programme have added value to all the participants and has motivated them to move forward in future to benefit larger population.


REPORT ON AIDS DAY CULTURAL PROGRAM AT ORPHAN HOME VENUE: SNEHA CARE HOME

REPORT ON FREE EYE SIGHT CHECK UP CAMP IN ASSOCIATION WITH TITAN EYE PLUS- 4TH DECEMBER 2018

A regular sight test is one of the most vital health check-up for eyes; it can help recognize early signs of eye conditions even before the warning symptoms show up. REPORT ON HEALTH SURVEY ON DIABETES AND HYPERTENSION

Krupanidhi College of Pharmacy (KCP) organized a health survey program for the villagers of Mullur in collaboration with RGUHS NSS cell from KCP on 26thfebrauary 2019.

The main objective of the health survey was to create an awareness about the most common conditions of the present era that is DIABETES and HYPERTENTION.


The health survey also involved the collection of the data about the immunization status of children born in past 5 years and also the cleanliness maintained in and around there homes of villagers.

The NSS volunteers visited the households in the village, enquiring about families with children less than five years of age and the people having hypertention and diabetes. The parents with children under 5 years of age were enrolled into the survey along with diabetic and hypertensive patients. The volunteers checked the immunization cards of the children (as and when available) to ensure completeness of immunization schedule. All the parents were verbally informed on the importance of immunization and were also given leaflets advocating the importance of child vaccination and the diseases against which government provides free vaccines to the children.

The volunteers even checked the medicine, health report and daily schedules of diabetic and hypertensive patients.

The outdoor events were flat running race for 100mts, lemon spoon race, relay race, kabaadi and tug of war.






REPORT ON SAPLING PLANTATION AT GOVERNMENT SCHOOL PREMISES, MULLUR VILLAGE
