
Dr. Siddarth has started his presentation by describing the basics of what is intellectual and asked students about the skills that students usually posses (singing, dancing, movie making, artistic, photography etc). He further explained how to identify what is the Intellectual.He explained about the current world scenario in protecting the intellectual property and described the examples of number of products (neem and curcumin) on which India has lost its control in international market.Dr. SiddarthMisra has also talked about the Trademark, different trademark types and how that represents a particular product or company.Heexplained the differenences between trademark, trade secret, copy right and who will be eligible to own it. Patent, trademark, and trade secret are industrial properties and copyright is an individual property.He explained about the copy right Act introduction in India, its terms and conditions and laws governing infringement in both civil and criminal cases. 


