SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Krupanidhi College of Pharmacy is committed to the goals of attracting and supporting top calibre students in the area of higher education.

In order that no student is denied the opportunity due to financial inadequacy, scholarships are provided by the institution, Government and non-government bodies and philanthropists. Scholarships are given to students on need basis and also to meritorious students.

The procedure of grant of scholarship by the management is clearly defined in the scholarship policy of the institution. Scholarship is either directly credited to the bank accounts of students by the granting authority or in case where the amount is credited to the institution, the same is immediately credited to the bank accounts of students. In case of Institutional Scholarship payment will be done online or in person through cash.

I. Mission Statement

II. Coverage

The candidates are eligible to avail the following concessions:

1. A concession in/complete waiver of tuition fees or partly waiver of the fees. **(As per management decision)**
2. Boarding and Lodging expenses **(As per management decision)**
3. Meal card **(As per management decision)**
4. Funding of Field trip/any similar excursion made in requirement of coursework. **(As per management decision)**

III. Eligibility

Date:

- The candidate must be a citizen of India
- Have received an unconditional admission offer from the college (applicable to 1st year applicants only)
- Have maintained the minimum attendance as specified by the college rules and regulations
- Candidate must not be a beneficiary of any other scholarship award provided by any party.

The award of scholarships will be made based on one or more of the following prerequisites:

- Academic Performance in the preceding academic year and marks obtained in Boards minimum 80% obtained in undergraduate course (for 1st year) for the economically deserving
- Academic merit
- Excellence in sports
- Excellence in social work or community service
- Economically Weak

IV. Application Process

The candidates are required to fill in the application form in the office of admission with self-attested copies of required documents as mentioned in the circular each year, within the time limit prescribed.

Candidates will be required to produce these documents in original for verification by the office whenever requested.

Any application found incomplete or incorrect will not be considered.

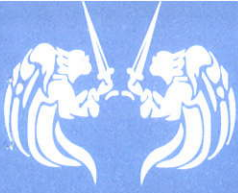
V. Selection
